Summary Activity Report 2022-2026

Since its creation in 2022, the Citizens Conference of Parties (C.C.O.P.) has conducted progressive and structured research, scoping, and conceptual development, consistent with its statutory purpose, the requirements of UN Resolution 70.1, and regional and national legal frameworks.

The year 2022 was dedicated to defining the foundational framework for C.C.O.P.'s work through the adoption of Resolution 1, “**United for GOOD.**” This resolution established a clear set of specifications for the development of new governance tools and frameworks, aimed at addressing the challenges of implementing the Sustainable Development Goals and the constitutional principles of states.

In 2023, activities focused primarily on fundamental research and capacity building, particularly in the areas of shared governance, non-financial accounting, and political theory. This work has helped consolidate the scientific, methodological, and cultural foundations necessary for designing a systemic governance infrastructure.

The year 2024 was marked by a temporary suspension of operational activities for family reasons. However, this period did not compromise the coherence or intellectual continuity of the project, as the conceptual foundations were preserved.

In 2025, the C.C.O.P. embarked on a new phase of work focused on finalizing the concepts and launching the first operational developments of the LUMEN program, thus preparing for a subsequent phase of deployment, dissemination, and funding.

Summary of Activities (2022–2025)

2022 — Foundational Framework

- Adoption of Resolution 1 – “United for GOOD” by the C.C.O.P.
- Definition of the conceptual and methodological specifications addressing:
 - United Nations Resolution 70.1,
 - the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs),
 - the fundamental values and constitutional principles of the G20 countries,
 - the challenges of implementation and systemic coordination.
- Clarification of the research, structuring, and experimentation mandate entrusted to the LUMEN program project manager.

2023 — Fundamental Research and Skills Development

- Fundamental research in systemic governance, cybernetics, and biomimetics.
- Studies and training in the following areas:
 - shared and democratic governance,
 - non-financial accounting and integration of non-monetary values,
 - contemporary political theory and global governance.
- Consolidation of the conceptual foundations necessary for a multi-level management infrastructure.

2024 — Temporary Suspension of Activities

- Partial pause in work for family reasons, without calling into question:
 - the established conceptual framework,
 - or the intellectual continuity of the project.
- Maintenance of strategic and documentary monitoring.

2025 — Finalization and Initial Developments

- Finalization of the structuring concepts of the LUMEN project.
- Transition from the research phase to initial operational development:
 - structuring of tools,
 - preparation of deliverables,
 - integration of conceptual, legal, and technical frameworks.
- Preparation for a deployment and funding phase.
