Resolution 1 (2022)

The General Assembly of the Citizens Conference of Parties,

Recalling [United Nations Resolution 70.1](#) and its 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, as well as the Paris Agreement (2015),

Recalling the [2019 Appeal to Humanity](#) by 11,000 scientists from 153 countries,

Recalling the statutes of the Citizens Conference of Parties,

Aware that [9 out of 10 countries are regressing in human development](#),

Aware that [several sets of figures](#) regularly released by various international organizations confirm the extent and acceleration of biodiversity loss and climate change.

Recognizing that the causes of the difficulties in implementing UN Resolution 70.1 can be resolved through a transdisciplinary, collaborative approach that fosters learning and values diversity, coherence, and equity, both in anticipation and follow-up.

Welcoming the progress in research, infrastructure, and collaboration in the following fundamental areas:

- Humanities (Psychology, neurology, economics, sociology, anthropology, philosophy, politics, etc.)
- Technical sciences (Physics, computer science, networks, modeling, etc.)
- Management sciences (frameworks, project management, coaching, etc.)
- Sustainable development in organizations (Associations, local authorities, businesses, governments, institutions, nations, etc.) and the integration of non-financial values into various legislative frameworks
- Transdisciplinarity (Cybernetics, systems theory, complexity science, biomimicry, etc.)

Welcoming with satisfaction all skills development initiatives that benefit [SDG 17](#): pedagogy, management, facilitation, regenerative impact finance, risk management, risk anticipation, and co-development of trust in uncertain domains.

Resolves :

- to promote awareness of the root causes and invisible consequences of human activity;
- to place the notions of common utility and general interest at the heart of the system for diagnosing needs, productive capacities, and the valuation and sharing of work;
- to collectively question, promote, and determine value systems that lead to the appreciation, definition, and monitoring of the balance of civilizational development;
- to promote awareness of the functioning of our psychological, neurological, and physiological systems;
- to promote awareness of humanity's place in its environment and to foster its reconnection with it, from the local to the global level and vice versa;
- to synthesize, cross-reference, and integrate interdisciplinary knowledge, both orthodox and heterodox;
- to promote new forms of cooperation and new forms of networked organizational management, centered on the Sustainable Development Goals and the co-regulation of emotions;
- to promote the collective implementation of operational strategies and implementing decrees for resolving the 17 SDGs
- To promote a scientific and technical approach in experimental territories that will serve as benchmarks and foundations for developments targeting broader and more sophisticated objectives, in a cooperative manner with teams experienced in new opportunities;
- To facilitate co-creation and the use of multifunctional tools, as well as new methods that facilitate informed decision-making and the means of their implementation.
